♦ [Givry Premier Cru Clos de la Servoisine 2016](#)

91 Points

A small parcel of 45-year-old vines within this premier cru has produced a wine rich in both tannins and fruits. That gives it good potential, deepening its rich black fruits and spice within the structure. The wine will develop well, so drink from 2022.

♦ [Givry Clos de Mortières 2016](#)

90 Points

This is a portion of the Ferté vinyard that was planted at least 30 years ago. It has a good balance between texture and fruity acidity that will stand it in good stead as it ages. The wine's freshness is already attractive. Drink from 2022.

♦ [Givry 2016](#)

89 Points

Grapes for this wine come from a 4.2 acre parcel that is neighbor to some of the best premier cru vineyards in Givry. Its tannins and freshness promise much, bringing together intense black-cherry fruits as well as acidity. The structure suggests the wine will be ready from 2021.
